



EPB TIME SHIFT PLAN – RESIDENTIAL RATE SCHEDULE

(EPB TIME-OF-USE RESIDENTIAL RATE – SCHEDULE TRS)

Availability

This rate shall apply only to electric service to a single-family dwelling (including its appurtenances if served through the same meter), where the major use of electricity is for domestic purposes such as lighting, household appliances, and the personal comfort and convenience of those residing therein.

Character of Service

Alternating current, single-phase, 60 hertz. Power shall be delivered at a service voltage available in the vicinity or agreed to by Distributor. Multiphase service shall be supplied in accordance with Distributor's standard policy.

Time Shift Rate Plan Charges

Customer Charge: \$9.81 per month

Energy Charge:

Summer Period 16.962¢ per kWh per month for all onpeak kWh, plus*
7.775¢ per kWh per month for all offpeak kWh*

Non-Summer Period 16.962¢ per kWh per month for all onpeak kWh, plus*
7.775¢ per kWh per month for all offpeak kWh*

Time Shift Rate Plan: Equals the Energy Charge + TVA Fuel cost adjustment.

Adjustment

The base customer charges and energy charges shall be increased or decreased in accordance with the current Adjustment Addendum published by TVA.

Determination of Seasonal Periods

Summer Period shall mean the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, and October. Non-Summer Period shall mean the months of November, December, January, February, and March billing months.



Determination of Onpeak and Offpeak Hours

Except for Saturdays and Sundays and the weekdays that are observed as Federal holidays for New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day, onpeak hours for each day shall be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. during the Summer Period and from 5 a.m. to 9 a.m. during the Non-Summer Period. For the Summer Period and the Winter Period, all other hours of each day that are not otherwise defined as onpeak hours and all hours of such excepted days shall be offpeak hours. Such times shall be Central Standard Time or Central Daylight Time, whichever is then in effect. Said onpeak and offpeak hours are subject to change by Distributor. In the event Distributor determines that such changed onpeak and offpeak hours are appropriate, it shall so notify TVA at least 2 months prior to the effective date of such changed hours, and Distributor shall promptly notify customer.

Determination of Onpeak and Offpeak Energy Amounts

The onpeak and offpeak kWh for any month shall be the energy amounts taken during the respective hours of the month designated under this rate schedule as onpeak and offpeak hours.

Minimum Monthly Bill

The base customer charge, as adjusted, constitutes the minimum monthly bill for all customers served under this rate schedule except those customers for which a higher minimum monthly bill is required under Distributor's standard policy because of special circumstances affecting Distributor's cost of rendering service.

Payment

Bills under this rate schedule will be rendered monthly. Any amount of the bill that is unpaid after the due date specified on bill may be subject to additional charges under Distributor's standard policy.

Contract Requirement

Customers choosing service under this schedule shall not be eligible to elect service under Base Rate – Residential Rate Schedule earlier than one year after beginning service under this schedule. However, there is no durational term resulting in a minimum bill when a customer terminates service under this rate schedule.

Single-Point Delivery



The charges under this rate schedule are based upon the supply of service through a single delivery and metering point, and at a single voltage.

Service is subject to Rules and Regulations of Distributor.
